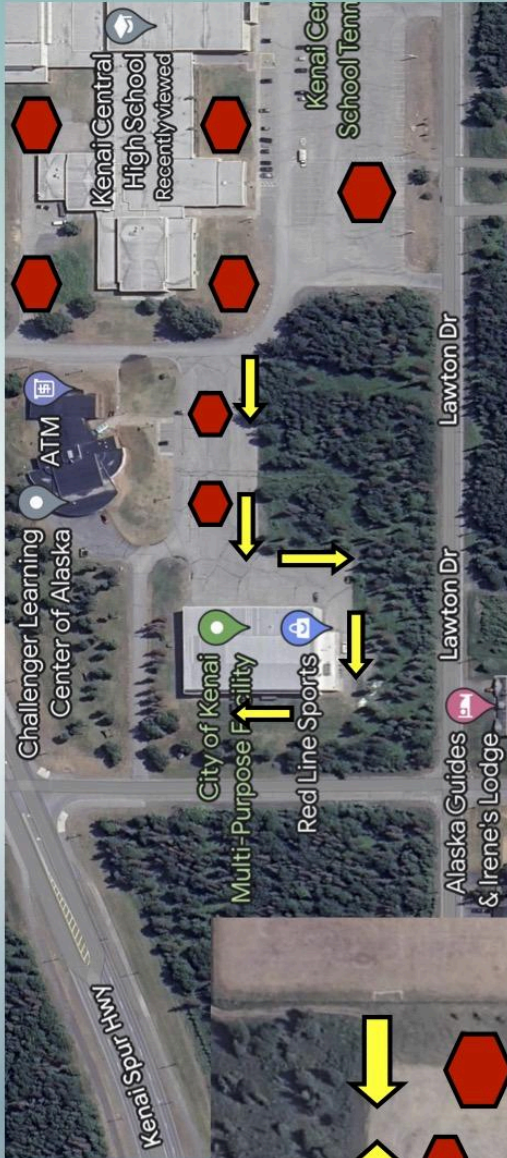
The AYSA Board encourages all participants to foster a supportive environment and keep the focus on the love of the game. Let's make this tournament a memorable and positive experience for everyone involved.

No camping on KCHS/KMS property

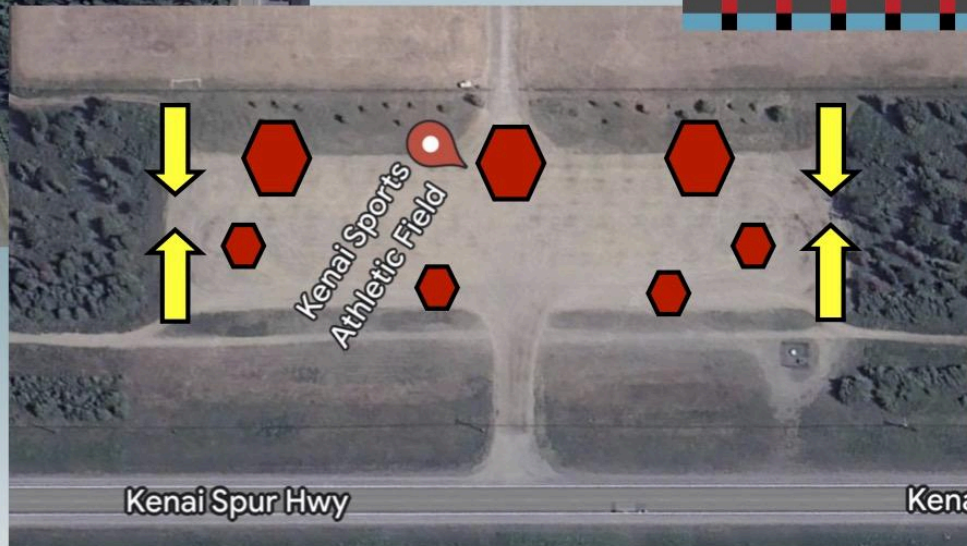
Be prepared to move upon request if not parked properly

Camping at these two sites is on a first come basis.



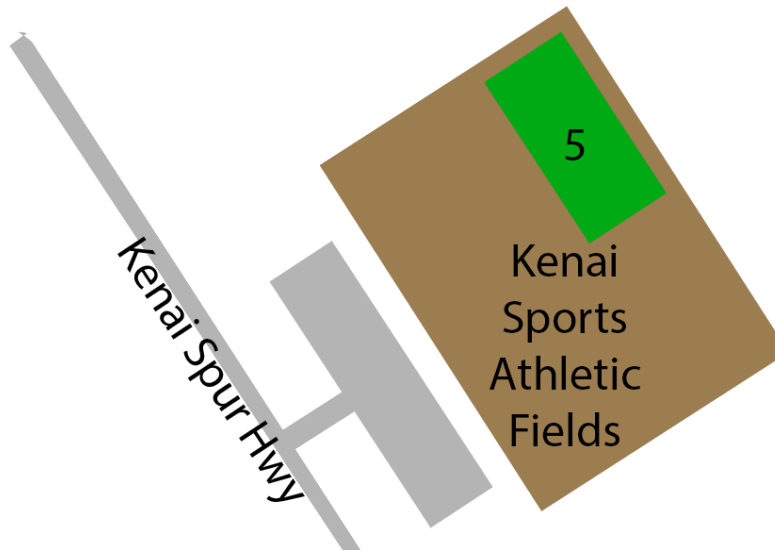
Field Maps

TIE BREAKERS

15.1 Procedure: In the event where two or more teams have accumulated an equal number of points within a group and are tied on the basis of points earned at the conclusion of preliminary play, the team's placement will be determined in accordance with the following sequential criteria. Tiebreakers will be considered in order until the tie is broken, then restarted to break the remaining tie. This tie-breaking procedure shall be used if necessary, to determine 1st and 2nd place standings within a flight, as well as determining the best 3rd place teams:

15.1.1 Winner in head-to-head competition

15.1.2 Winner of the most games. The team with the most wins advances

15.1.3 Cumulative goal differential between goals scored and goals allowed in all games played within the team's flight. maximum difference allowed is four (4) goals per game

15.1.4 Fewest goals allowed in all games played within the team's flight

15.1.5 Kicks from the penalty mark per FIFA law. This tie-breaking procedure shall be used if necessary, to determine 1st and 2nd place standings within each flight

15.1.6 If, in the opinion of the event State Cup Committee, additional steps are required to ensure the safe conclusion of the competition are needed, those decisions will be communicated to all affected teams before they are implemented.

15.2 Two or More Teams Tied: If more than two (2) teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round, the tie-breaking criteria listed will be used in the order shown, beginning at (b), to either advance or eliminate one team. The remaining teams will then be compared, beginning with criteria (a) to determine the final placement.

DIVISIONS AND DURATION OF GAMES

U11-U12 30 minute halves, 10 minute halftime, 2x5 minute overtime in knockout games

U13-U14 35 minute halves, 10 minute halftime, 2x10 minute overtime in knockout games

U15-U16 40 minute halves, 10 minute halftime, 2x15 minute overtime in knockout games

U17-U19 45 minute halves, 10 minute halftime, 2x15 minute overtime in knockout games

13.3 Overtime Periods: For semifinal/championship games tied at the end of regulation play, two complete overtime periods will be played.

13.3.1 If a game is still tied at the end of the prescribed overtime play, FIFA "Kicks from the Penalty Mark" rules will apply to determine the winner using the 9 or 11 players on the field at the conclusion of the second overtime and following the FIFA Laws of the Game.

13.4 Match Manipulation: Teams failing to compete in the spirit of the competition, or involved in the manipulation of a game result are subject to forfeiture and disqualification from all levels of Alaska State Cup competition, and the US Youth Soccer National Championship Series 13.4.1 If failing to compete is observed and confirmed by the Alaska Youth Soccer officials and/ or State Cup Committee will give notice to the offending team or teams, and

13.4.2 If corrective action is not taken, the team or teams will be subject to disqualification.

Open sign up is for kids who have experience in organized soccer, and are under 11 years old - 2017, 16, 15 and 14 (2014 will be limited). Open to those who typically play 7v7 or are skill-appropriate for 7v7. Parents please use your best judgment as to whether your player is able to participate and enjoy this type of play.

Other Info

- Team makeups will be both full teams that sign up as a team with a max roster of 12 as well as teams formed from individuals who sign up before the end of the day August 1.
- Signups are first-come first-served and limited to the first 100 players who will form up to 8 teams.
- This is not a USYS sanctioned event. The 7s Jamboree 100 Open is an Open Competition hosted by KPSC.
- Games 1 and 2 will start at 10:00am and we'll have 20 minute halves with 5 minute half time. New games will begin on the hour on both fields.
- We'll have a minimum of 4 coaches and 2 refs on the facility at all times to run the teams through their games, up to 16 games.
